


















ORGANISATION CHART OF JCI HONG KONG

BUSINESS AFFAIRS

The Business Affairs area emphasizes creating opportunities and partnerships for members, highlighted by initiatives such as the JCI Creative Young Entrepreneur Award (CYEA), which promotes business innovation and enhances pitching skills. Tan Ho Chan from JCI City and Edmund Chan from JCI Dragon were notably recognized in this competition.

The Connect Hong Kong Business Evolve Luncheon, in collaboration with the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in Bangkok, the Hong Kong Trade Development Council, and The Hong Kong Tourism Board, showcased Hong Kong's business advantages to numerous guests. The event featured the JCI in Business (JIB) Launch & Mega International Business Matching, attracting over 500 members from 20 countries and

resulting in 7 MoUs, reinforcing Hong Kong's status as a global finance and trade hub. The National Business Networking (NBN) initiative also engaged over 100 young professionals in discussions on ESG for SMEs and branding strategies, supported by a WhatsApp group for ongoing collaboration among JCI Hong Kong members.









CORPORATE COMMUNICATIONS

To correspond JCIHK's theme, Connect to Evolve, the corporate communications area connect different parties by establishing news through different social media platforms. Through Facebook and Instagram, we successfully connected with other countries' JCI, and there are also enquiries from foreign Jaycees, asking information about the National Convention. Furthermore, as a result of creating posts regularly, we are able to maintain exposure on social media platforms, hence our followers have been continuously increasing.

One of the recent post with highest click rate is supporting the International Human Duties Day, we advocate or members to change their profile picture with the photo frame, and we also created posts to promote International Human Duties Day. We have over 100 members responded and switched their profile pictures.

Champion of Champions (COC)

So far in 2025, 5 COC events has been held, the latest event was the pillow fight hosted by JCI Shatin. We hope that through COC competition can increase the incentive of chapters participation, and the results are satisfactory.



ENVIRONMENTAL, SOCIAL AND GOVERNANCE

This year, JCIHK adopted the 'Connect to Evolve' slogan, reinforcing our engagement across societal sectors for growth and social impact. In our successful first quarter, we held a notable National Business Networking cum ESG seminar welcoming over 70 attendees, featuring talks from Prof. Carlos Lo, Miss Harriet Kong, and Miss Emily Li, with Miss Tina So moderating. These discussions provided valuable insights and networking opportunities.

At the Cyberport Career Fair 2024, we engaged with 2000+ youths and over 90 exhibitors, sharing our community projects. Additionally, we signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Negawatt ZERO2 at the "Live Local 2024 Campaign" launch, aiming to promote a green lifestyle and contribute to a low-carbon economy in Hong Kong, highlighting our commitment to sustainability and social change.









INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

Internationalism is one of the key elements of JCI. We had a total of 257 members who attended the Asia and Pacific Conference at Angkor, Cambodia this year. JCI Hong Kong has hosted 8 events during ASPAC and congratulations to all winners during the award ceremony.



This year, we are glad to have held several reception dinners for JCI President Senator Kaveen Kumar Kumaravel, JCI Vice President Senator Mark Joseph David, as well as JCI Executive Committee during Mid Year Evaluation in Hong Kong.

During JCI Hong Kong Greater Bay Area Business trip, we welcomed National Presidents and their members from 5 different countries to enjoy the great vibe in Hong Kong during our cultural tours. We hope to foster more internationalism and connect more with each other and evolve together for a better world.















LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

In 2024, a series of Chairmanship Workshop Series is set to enhance chairmanship and protocol skills among JC members at various stages, featuring insights from past National Presidents. One standout workshop, "Transform Your Approach to Change with JCI Hong Kong" led by 2006 JCI President Senator Lars Hajslund, delve into change management and the cultivation of a change-driven mindset for effective leadership. Additionally, the 2024 JCI World Public Speaking and Debate Championship includes a preparatory workshop to sharpen participants' skills, with special sessions by past Debate Champions to gear up the JCI Hong Kong Debate team for the ASPAC competition. The Executive Academy, continuing its successful collaboration with JCI Macao, offers a 2-day training camp in Macao with over 50 participants, aiming to polish leadership qualities and foster connections. Lastly, the President Academy gathers LOM future leaders and allows them to learn from experienced coaches and past National Presidents, promoting unity and innovative leadership approaches.

MEMBERSHIP AFFAIRS

The JCI Hong Kong Membership Team, under the mission "Unlock the Power of Membership: Join, Engage, Thrive!", worked to unite 21 local chapters, fostering both their growth and development. Recognizing the need for skill enhancement, the team organized two workshops led by subject matter experts, focusing on strategies for recruitment, conversion, and retention. These efforts paid off, with nearly 100 new members joining through orientations held on March 1 and May 24, thanks to the practical training and inspiring talks. Additionally, the Membership Team's holistic approach was evident through two 5-Star Training Camps that helped 75 new members find their JCI pathway, develop career skills, and expand social networks. This comprehensive strategy not only increased membership numbers but also improved member quality and engagement, effectively connecting and evolving the 21 chapters in membership affairs.















RECORDS & RECOGNITION

Our first E-Bidbook Seminar this year was successfully held on 16 February (Wed) at the JCIHK Office with over 50 participants - Full House achieved! Our second Bidbook Seminar was successfully held on 6 July (Wednesday) in a physical format, with over 60 participants joining the Chamber Office! Thank you for the support from all 21 Chapters, including Chapter Presidents, Board of Directors, Project Chairmen and Project Organizing Committee Members.









YOUTH COLLABORATION & SUSTAINABILITY

Over the last quarter, the Youth Collaboration and Sustainability team has been actively engaging with local youth organizations, notably WoFoo Leaders' Network and CLAP@JC, to foster future partnerships. A significant achievement was organizing the upcoming Asia Pacific Youth Micro Movie Festival scheduled for November, with all necessary arrangements completed and film submissions rolling in. Additionally, the team successfully conducted a sustainability forum in collaboration with Ocean Park Corporation, offering over 50 young individuals insights into sustainable practices. In response to the critical need for blood donations, a blood drive was organized in May, aligning with the Declaration of Human Duties and Responsibilities. This event saw enthusiastic participation from 50 members of local chapters and youth

service users, significantly contributing to replenishing local blood inventories.









TEN OUTSTANDING YOUNG PERSONS (TOYP) SELECTION

The theme of the Ten Outstanding Young Persons Selection 2024, "Keep Striving" (傑出·從未停步) aims to spread the message that Hong Kong people's pursuance of excellence for a better future transcends the passage of time, and that the spirit of the Outstanding Young Person lives on from generation to generation through inspiring stories and impactful encounters.

The Kick-off Ceremony took place successfully on May 28, 2024, with over 120 participants sharing in this special occasion. SDG Enterprise Awards 2024

To recognise companies' contributions to the SDGs, Junior Chamber International Victoria (JCI Victoria) has organised the Sustainable Development Goals Enterprise Awards (SDG Enterprise Awards) annually since 2020. SDG Enterprise Awards 2024 builds upon the previous success and continues to recognise companies that actively promote and work towards sustainable development.

AED Save a Life

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and use of an Automated external defibrillator (AED) can greatly increase a person's chance of survival when performed in the first few minutes of cardiac arrest. The project enhanced public awareness of the importance of AED as well as promoting knowledge of handling cardiac arrest with AED and CPR, by organizing AED training sessions for young leaders and AED themed fun day to the general public.

"SEN" to the World

With the slogan of "'SEN' to the World, We are the Same", the project aims to raise public awareness and understanding of special education needs (SEN) children hence promoting social inclusion, by providing a public space for different parties to show their talent.

Pet to School

The project aims to educate our next generation about the concept of harmonious coexistence between humans and pets. Over 30 volunteers from JCI Victoria with well trained dog teachers have organized the 1st pet care fun day in Hong Kong, in a local primary school, advocating responsible pet ownership and raising awareness of animal welfare to primary school students.

In the dynamic year of 2024, JCI Kowloon has embraced the empowering theme of "Connect, Unite, Rise." Through a diverse array of impactful initiatives, we has worked tirelessly to cultivate a better future for both its members and the broader community.

One of the standout achievements of the year has been the "The Entrepreneurial Journey of Hong Kong Artisans Series" under the Business Affairs Area. Recognizing the immense potential of local entrepreneurs, JCI Kowloon invited distinguished guests such as Mr. Michael Cheung (the founder of Sole Craft), Ms. Yuka (a Sphere Joint Doll Artist and Guinness World Record holder), and Ms. Porsche Ngai (the founder of Candies by WhiteQ and a Korea Candle Crafts Association Aroma Candle Master Instructor), to share their experiences building businesses, inspiring the next generation of Hong Kong innovators.

With the aim of empowering young individuals to manage stress and cultivate a positive life outlook, the organization hosted a distress game workshop in May, which attracted over 90 secondary student participants. Guided

by the expertise of Senator Ban Chui and Jasmine Fong, a Registered Counselling Psychologist and Fellow of the Hong Kong Psychological Society, the event provided a transformative platform for the youth to explore strategies for emotional well-being and personal growth.

Recognizing the immense value of effective public speaking and presentational skills, JCI Kowloon curated a comprehensive 12-hour training program "MC in the House", with the Mr. Alvin Li, a professional MC, serving as the Head Trainer. The program's success was evident as participants not only enhanced their abilities but also gained the opportunity to showcase their newfound talents by acting as MCs at various events.

Alongside its domestic initiatives, JCI Kowloon has strengthened its international connections, maintaining ties with seven sister chapters across Asia. We organized a joint meeting with JCI Nagoya. In March, JCI Kowloon visited Malaysia for JCI Kuala Lumpur's 70th Anniversary. 




